EUROPEAN RESEARCH AREA

- ERA is the ambition to create a single, borderless market for research, innovation and technology across the EU.
 - It helps countries be more effective together, by strongly aligning their research policies and programmes. The free circulation of researchers and knowledge enables better cross-border cooperation, building of critical mass, continent-wide competition.
- New ERA Policy Agenda with 20 concrete ERA actions for the period 2022-2024 ⇒ national contributions ⇒ National ERA Action Plan



EUROPEAN RESEARCH AREA ACTIONS 1, 3 & 4

- Action 1 | Enable the open sharing of knowledge and the re-use of research outputs, including through the development of the European Open Science Cloud (EOSC)
- Action 3 | Advance towards the reform of the Assessment System for research, researchers and institutions to improve their quality, performance and impact
- Action 4 | Promote attractive and sustainable research careers, balanced talent circulation and international, transdisciplinary and intersectoral mobility across the ERA
- National ERA Action Plan expected to pass Austrian Council of Ministers in December 2022
